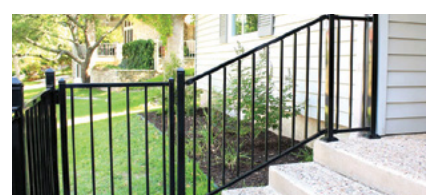

INGREDIENTS

- 12 oz rotini or bowtie pasta
- 2 cups corn (fresh, grilled, or canned)
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes (halved)
- 1/2 cup red onion (finely diced)
- 1/2 cup crumbled feta or cotija cheese
- 1/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup sour cream
- Juice of 1 lime
- 1 tsp chili powder
- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- Salt & pepper to taste
- Fresh cilantro (optional)



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cook pasta according to package directions. Drain and let cool completely.
2. Grill or sauté corn until lightly charred.
3. In a large bowl, combine pasta, corn, tomatoes, onion, and cheese.
4. In a separate bowl, mix mayo, sour cream, lime juice, and seasonings.
5. Pour dressing over pasta mixture and toss until well coated.
6. Chill for at least 30 minutes before serving.
7. Garnish with cilantro and an extra sprinkle of chili powder.

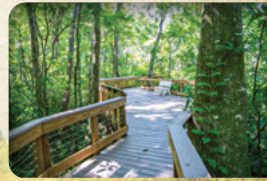
